Internship Programme Overview

The Internship Programme offers a unique opportunity for selected undergraduate and postgraduate students to deepen their knowledge and practical experience in STEM education. Designed to create meaningful impact for both educators and learners, the programme provides structured placements that align closely with each intern's field of study. This ensures that participants gain relevant, hands-on experience while achieving valuable learning outcomes.

Objectives

The Internship Programme aims to:

- Provide students with practical learning opportunities in areas such as international cooperation, project coordination, administration, secretarial support, accounting, and information technology;
- Enhance students' educational experiences through supervised, practical work assignments; and
- Introduce students to regional and international working environments that support employability, career development, and professional networking.

Eligibility

- Third- or fourth-year undergraduate students
- Graduate or postgraduate students
- Applicants whose academic background is relevant to the internship scope

Duration

- Minimum 4 months

Internship Conditions

SEAMEO STEM-ED may provide interns with a minimal stipend to partially cover food and incidental expenses, subject to budget availability.



Volunteer Overview

Volunteer engagement at SEAMEO STEM-ED is open to individuals seeking hands-on experience while contributing to the Centre's initiatives. Participation is not tied to academic requirements and is designed to accommodate short-term or flexible commitments. Depending on mutual agreement, volunteers may support activities such as programme management, educator professional development, curriculum design, administrative and operational tasks, research, or knowledge management.

Key Features

- Open to individuals seeking opportunities for skill-building and professional growth
- Exposure to programme management, organisational, and operational functions
- Independent of university or academic credit requirements
- Flexible, short-term engagement (e.g., one month or longer, subject to agreement)
- Project-based or task-specific contributions aligned with Centre operation
